a.) Beer Application for Tennessee Alabama Fireworks

Mayor Jackson stated that Tennessee Alabama Fireworks located at 139 Highway 72 South Pittsburg, TN owned by Michael Collar has applied for an off premises beer permit. Chief Jordan has completed the background checks for all owners over 5% and the manager with the background check showing a cleared status with only one misdemeanor on Michael Collar. The board reviewed the application in depth. Motion was made by **Alderman Payne**, seconded by **Alderman Sisk** to approve Tennessee Alabama Firework's Beer Permit for an Off Premises Permit. The motion passed unanimously on a board vote.

Mayor Jackson wanted to inform the board that the renters of the property at 1184 Main Street formerly the Hang Out have inquired about a Beer Permit and Liquor by the Drink.


