**a.) Hire a Post Certified Police Officer**

Mayor Pesnell stated there were seven applicants for this position and all seven were given an interview. The applicants were as follows: Frederick Allen, Jessica Anderson, Corey Beasley, Donald Dykes, Emily Huston, Charlie Rittenberry and Josh Winters.

A motion was made by **Alderman Payne**, seconded by **Alderman Sisk** on the Police Chief's recommendation to hire Charlie Rittenberry as the new Police Officer. The motion passed unanimously on a board vote.

**b.) Any Other Properly Presented Business**

Mayor Pesnell stated the Freightliner Garbage Truck had a lug nut to back out which will cost the town approximately \$1,800 for the repairs. The town is reviewing the warranty at this time.

Mayor Pesnell stated the town needs to visit Cherokee Truck Rental and look at the used bucket trucks they have in stock as the town has been looking for a good used one for our maintenance department.

Alderman Sisk stated the Police Black and White Crown Vic is running, all it needed was a new set of spark plugs. However, the Police Black Dodge Charger will be more expensive to fix than the car is worth.


Alderman Matthews stated he had spoken with Mr. King in the Parks Department and the rain was preventing him from mowing.


