GENERAL BUSINESS

There was a Motion to approve the April 9, 2009 minutes.

NEW BUSINESS

The architect for the concession stand at the Barn location is Pat Bales. Mayor Jackson and Mr. Bales reviewed the layout of the building. The Board will vote to accept or not accept the plans for the concession stand. The position of the concession stand will be facing the parking lot and the soccer fields. Mayor Jackson is concerned about the state giving an approval for a septic line. Pat Bales will speak with Tim Taylor on this matter. Marc Lawrence asks what the projected cost will be for the concession stand. Mayor Jackson said he thought the quoted cost was one hundred seven or eight dollars per square foot and the grant money will be used toward this. Mr. Bales will bid out the building of the concession stand. Marc asks if it were possible to have the baseball field by the summer of 2010. Mayor Jackson stated that it would depend on revenues and how much the grant will allow.

The town has an application for a forestry grant from the Tennessee Forestry Division. We can apply for this and possibly get up to \$20,000.00 and this is a 50/50 match. The trees have to mature to 40 feet or taller. The Town Board voted to apply for this grant.

Fall soccer registration will be held on 8-8-09, 8-15-09, and 8-22-09 at the Town Hall. The first game will be 9-12-09. Advertising for fall soccer will be done in the same order as it was for spring soccer. Three row bleachers will be purchased for each field

and benches purchased for the U-9, U-12 and U-19 teams. The Park Grant will be used toward this purchase. Mayor Jackson will continue the fencing on the soccer fields along the side of the road with a double gate at the end. The Mayor is considering paving the parking lot at the soccer field, because this is also part of the grant. The grant money is to mainly be used on the soccer program because there are no soccer complexes in Marion County.


