PEDDLER/SOLICITOR/REGISTERED SOLICITOR ORDINANCE SUMMARY

The Town of Kimball Ordinance No. 207 regulates Peddlers, Solicitors, and Registered Solicitors operating in the Town. If you plan to conduct business in Kimball as a peddler, solicitor, or registered solicitor, you should be aware of the following:

All persons peddling, soliciting, or registered soliciting in Kimball must first obtain a town permit. Each individual peddler, solicitor, or registered solicitor must apply for permit in person and must show driver's license or government issued identification at the time of the application.

Peddlers, Solicitors, or Registered Solicitors must visibly display their permit in a conspicuous place while conducting business in the Town of Kimball.

Peddlers, Solicitors, or Registered Solicitors must not approach a residence that is displaying a "No Solicitors" sign.

The following activities are prohibited and will result in the revocation of your peddler's, solicitor's, or registered solicitor's permit and may result in penalties:

- Providing false information on your permit application.
- Failing to provide proof of license or registration, and identification when requested; or using the license or registration of another person.
- Conducting business before 8:00 am or after 4:00 pm (CST).
- Conducting business in a way to create a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of any individual or the general public.
- No peddler, solicitor or registered solicitor shall have any exclusive right to any location in the public streets, parks or public rights of way, nor be permitted a stationary location, nor be permitted to operate in any congested area where operations might impede or inconvenience the public.
- Making false or misleading statements about the product or service being sold, including untrue statements or endorsements.
- Claiming to have the endorsement of the Town solely based on the Town having issued a permit, license or certificate of registration to that person.
- Remaining on the property of another when requested to leave, or to otherwise conduct business in a manner a reasonable person would find obscene, threatening, intimidating or abusive.

Violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$50 per offense, plus court costs. Each violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense and punishable as such.

I hereby affirm that the information provided on this application is correct upon penalty of voiding any permit issued hereunder. I also affirm that I have read the above summary of the Town ordinance as it pertains to peddling and soliciting. I understand and agree to follow the rules and regulations. I understand that if I do not follow the rules and regulations my permit may be revoked and I may be subject to penalty.
